DON's \$2.5 Million Campaign is Underway

On September 15, the Department of the Navy kicked off their Combined Federal Campaign in the Pentagon Hall of Heroes. The event featured keynote remarks from Mr. Andrew Edwards, founder of the Academic Empowerment Foundation (AEF). AEF is a charity that supports the academic needs of high school students within the Washington DC Metropolitan Area. The AEF represented the over 20,000 charities that benefit from funds raised by the CFC.

The CFC has a powerful impact on the welfare of the community, This year, the Department of Navy has set a goal of \$2.5 million, which is the highest goal throughout the entire CFCNCA. In order to reach (and exceed) this goal it is critical to participate in the ongoing events and fundraisers that will take place throughout the campaign.

- 3 View and select your online giving platform (determined by agency and payment preference).

Your payment options for the three online giving platforms are as follows:



- Payroll Deduction*
- Credit/Debit Card One-Time
- Credit/Debit Card Recurring
- eCheck One-Time
- eCheck Recurring

- Payroll Deduction only*

**The availability of and the platform for online payroll deduction will vary based on the donor's agency.*
